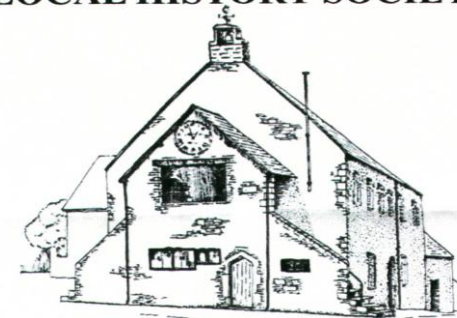
AIMS OF THE SOCIETY
